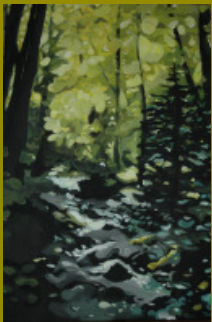

Building on the first Institute held in 2006, Library Leader’s Institute II offers an informal setting for reflection on the day-to-day professional and personal concerns of library leaders. Focus will be on the exchange of ideas, the solving of problems and the consideration of leadership and succession issues.
